Ken Double, Organ



Ken is currently a featured organist on the Mighty Mo, the great Moller organ at the Atlanta Fox Theatre. He was president of the American Theatre Organ Society for ten years. He is now Director of Fundraising for restoring the largest playing musical instrument in the world, the Midmer-Losh organ at Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, NJ.

For 33 years, this Chicago native was a sportscaster while continuing his musical interests. Then he played his first solo concert in 1978. In 1982 he began his association with the Long Center in Lafayette, IN, where he continues to play an annual June concert.

Daniel Mata, Vocalist



Daniel was one of three triplets born to his opera-loving mother, Maria, in Venezuela. After moving to the Atlanta area, he attend Lassiter High School where he began belting out opera classics.

He won the inaugural Stars of Tomorrow in Atlanta at age 14. Afterwards he appeared at the Atlanta Fox Theatre, the Vatican in Rome, and Marietta's Strand Theatre.

He won the prestigious Hearst Scholarship and will graduate from Belmont University in Nashville, TN, in Spring 2019.
