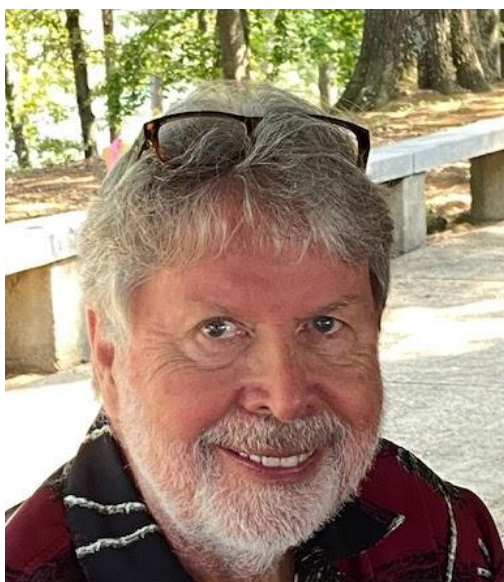

Auditions for the Grace Moore Scholarship (offered biennially) will be held on Saturday, April 30, 2022, at First Cumberland Presbyterian Church in Chattanooga, TN.

This scholarship, established in 1947 by the Tennessee Federation of Music Clubs, honors Grace Moore, Chattanooga's very own opera and movie star. While the auditions had been held in Murfreesboro for the last twenty years, they are appropriately being brought back to Chattanooga next year where they originated almost seventy-five years ago. The CMC is proud to sponsor the event.

Competition is open to Tennessee-born singers between the ages of 18 and 30 who are interested in studying and preparing for careers in opera. The winners will receive considerable amounts.
